Things you will need:

White/coloured paper, scissors, tape, pencil, 1 green and 1 yellow pipe cleaners, ribbon, child's hand to draw around and an adult's help

How to make:



Items you will need.
You could use any coloured paper, pink and blue might be nice, just like Boofle's bouquet!



On the paper draw around your child's hand.



Cut out your hand print. If you have any pencil marks just rub them out.



Curl the bottom of the hand shape into a cone leaving a small hole and secure with some tape.



Using a rounded pencil/pen curl each one of the fingers outwards.



Your flower should then look like this.



The yellow pipe cleaner should be half the size of the green one. Fold the yellow pipe cleaner in half, then make a hook/J shape with the green pipe cleaner.



Hook the green pipe cleaner over the middle of the yellow one then bend one side of the yellow pipe cleaner in half again.



Pinch the 'J' shape of the green pipe cleaner together and twist a little if there's enough. Take the longer end of the yellow pipe cleaner and wrap it tightly around the shorter side of the yellow pipe cleaner. Keep wrapping until you reach the end of the yellow pipe cleaner.



Take the pipe cleaner stem and poke it through the middle of the flower, pulling it so the green stem is below the flower and the yellow part is in the middle. Repeat the steps to make as many flowers as you would like and secure together with some ribbon.
